BEEHIVE READER

-  Reading Recognition Certificate
-  Participation in the Summer Reading “Bee Bash”
-  Bee pencil and bookmark






BUZZING BEE READER

A Buzzing Bee Reader must complete 20 activities from the June & July “Bee” A Summer Reader Calendars. Calendars and activity projects need to be turned in to the school library by **August 27, 2009**. A Buzzing Bee Reader will be rewarded with:

-  Certificate from Papa Murphy's
-  Reading Recognition Certificate
-  Participation in the Summer Reading “Bee Bash”
-  Bee pencil, eraser, stickers, and a bookmark

BEE KEEPER READER

A Bee Keeper Reader must participate in a public library summer reading program and complete 20 activities from the June & July “Bee” A Summer Reader Calendar. Your public library participation form, completed calendars and activity projects need to be turned in to the school library by **August 27, 2009**. A Bee Keeper Reader will be rewarded with:

-  Certificate from Papa Murphy's
-  Reading Recognition Certificate
-  Participation in the Summer Reading “Bee Bash”
-  Entry into a drawing for a Honeybee stuffed animal (one per grade level, 1st-4th)
-  Bee pencil, eraser, stickers, and bookmark
