Below are listed items presented for inclusion as Board identified District Annual Operating Goals for SY16-17:

- Develop and implement a plan for the first year of digital learning which includes, training, curriculum and implementation.
- Pass, plan, design, bid and construct facilities approved within the 2017 Bond Issue vote.
- Continue to develop mutually beneficial projects and initiatives with community partners. Work specifically with the City of Edmond on a shared school/tennis facility. Work with the City of Edmond on future road improvement projects at Danforth and Kelly, Thomas Avenue, Sorghum Mill at Heritage Elementary and Covell and Air Depot.
- Review and of Board policy and administrative regulations, and update as needed Attendance, Social Media, Digital Devices, Fiscal Integrity, Recording and Videotaping.
- Implement new curriculum standards and transition from 9 weeks benchmark tests to frequent common formative assessments with expedited analysis, re-teaching and re-assessment.
- Focus upon Middle School academic rigor specifically focusing on mathematics, computer science and science. Study the possible implementation of the AVID (AP, Pre-AP curriculum and teaching strategies) at targeted middle schools.
- Develop and implement a plan which increases and enhances the opportunities and resources for STEM classes and courses in elementary and secondary schools.
- Work to lower class sizes at all grade levels.
- Long-Range Facilities Plan: Review and update proposed bond projects for 2017 and the district's 5-year bond plan.
- Engage with state legislative processes in ways that will advance the quality of public education .
- Communicate with and engage the community with regard to district-level issues of strategic importance.
