Curriculum, Teaching and Learning

1. Focus upon Middle School academic rigor specifically focusing on mathematics, computer science and science. Review curriculum for imbedded pre-AP teaching strategies.
2. Review staffing and course offerings for parity of course offerings within middle schools.
3. Study and report on the potential of additional MS Foreign Language offerings.
4. Develop and implement a plan which increases and enhances the opportunities and resources for STEM classes and courses in elementary and secondary schools

Elementary – focus on maker spaces, coding, STEM rooms. Provide equipment grants based upon a school's STEM plan.

Secondary – emphasis on robotics, HS/MS Gateway Programs, computer science.

Curriculum, Teaching and Learning (continued)

5. Review the district's literature selection process. Review and implement a communication plan of class offerings, literary selections and studies in those courses.
6. Study strategies for integration of other instructional models using digital technology.
7. Study and review SAT/ACT as the district designated graduation test.
8. Study and review the current elementary reading screening test (RTI, curriculum).
9. Research and review school districts who are currently piloting ICAP to assist Edmond in its selection in the spring of 2018.

Governance, Quality and Excellence Activities

1. Review School Board policies and administrative regulations, and update as needed.
2. Review and update the District Athletic Handbook, coaches and student athlete code of conducts

Governance, Quality and Excellence Activities (continued)

3. Provide to the Board of Education a proposal for a limited neighborhood attendance zone for Clegern Elementary beginning in the 2018-19 School Year with kindergartners.

Governmental, Community, Parental Engagement and Outreach

1. Engage with state legislative processes in ways that will advance the quality of public education.
2. Continue, strengthen and explore additional mutually beneficial projects and initiatives with community partners.
3. Work specifically with the City of Edmond on a shared school/tennis facility. Work with the City of Edmond on future road improvement projects at Danforth and Kelly and Thomas Avenue.
4. Communicate with and engage the community with regard to district-level issues of strategic importance.

Human Resources

1. Continue to development new strategies to hire, develop and retain the highest quality leadership, instructional and support staff.
2. Work to lower class sizes at all grade levels.
3. Provide a plan by department of prioritized hiring requests.
4. Provide training on customer service to district support employees.

Operations

1. Plan, design, bid and construct facilities approved within the 2017 Bond Issue vote.
2. Long-Range Facilities Plan: Conduct school needs assessments, review and update proposed bond projects for 2019 and the district's 5-year bond plan.

Technology

1. Continued implementation of the digital conversion (third year) Develop and implement a plan for the fourth year / third year of deployment, which shall include evaluation of third year planning and implementation, continued development of digital course work, professional development and training, digital learning which includes training, curriculum and implementation.
