

TEXTBOOK SELECTION AND ADOPTION

Local Committee

The Superintendent shall appoint a local textbook committee, consisting of not less than three (3) nor more than nine (9) teachers employed in the public schools of the District, of which a majority shall be classroom teachers, and one (1) lay member. The Superintendent or his/her designee shall serve as chairperson of the local textbook committee. The local textbook committee shall serve without compensation and shall cease to exist when local adoptions have been completed and shall be replaced in the same manner each year as is provided by state law.

The duties of the local textbook committee are to contact publishers of textbooks/software/ materials selected by the state textbook committee, examine any or all new adoptions in the subjects taught in schools in the District, adopt textbooks from the multiple list selected by the state textbook committee in such manner as prescribed by the State Board of Education, and review any requests for re-evaluation of currently adopted textbooks.
