

PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENTS/HOME SCHOOLED STUDENTS

Students enrolling in the Edmond Public Schools from a non-accredited school in grades 1-8 must take a test before they may be enrolled. Completion of the information data sheet will serve as an application for testing and permission to enroll. The testing should be administered by the principal, counselor, or a teacher in the school enrolling the student. The student's informational data sheet, with the test results recorded on it, should be signed by the principal and counselor and placed in the student's progress folder as proof of validation.

Students requesting validation of credits from a non-accredited school at the high school level must submit an official transcript from the school to the receiving school and fill out an information data sheet provided by the Edmond Public Schools. Students requesting validation of credits in English, mathematics, social studies, or science will be administered appropriate tests. Decisions on validating all other electives will be made by the receiving school by testing the student in the elective areas. Considerations should be given to the type of program participated in, facilities and equipment, type of activities, number of hours per week, etc. No credit will be given for tutorial study. The student must have attended a regularly organized school meeting daily. Only passing grades (A, B, C, D or D-) from non-accredited schools will be considered. Students who are denied credit may appeal the decision to a system review committee. To request an appeal, the student or his/her counselor should contact the Associate Superintendent of Educational Services.
