

FOOD SERVICES: CHILD NUTRITION PROGRAM

The school cafeterias shall be operated for the benefit and convenience of the children of Edmond Public Schools. They shall be non-profit insofar as possible in their operation. All school cafeterias will operate under the Child Nutrition Act of 1966, the National School Lunch Act and the School Breakfast Program and will comply with all rules and regulations of the Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) Section 7, Parts 210, 220, and 245. Edmond Public Schools and its employees will also comply with all agreements entered into with the Child Nutrition Programs Section of the Oklahoma State Department of Education.

Applications for free and reduced price meals may be made at the principal's office. Building principals will review applications and determine eligibility. Households that do not qualify for benefits will receive written notification. If benefits are refused, parents or guardians may request orally or in writing a formal appeal by contacting the Associate Superintendent of District Operations at 1001 W. Danforth, Edmond, Oklahoma. Students who qualify for free or reduced price meals will remain anonymous and be treated just as paying students.
