

TRANSFERS, STUDENT INTER-DISTRICT

The Edmond Public Schools Board of Education recognizes that its foremost responsibility is to provide quality educational services for students who live within the legal, geographic boundaries of the District.

Edmond Public Schools faces ongoing challenges in providing teaching, administrative and support staff as well as adequate classroom teaching and co-curricular activity facilities and related equipment. It is, therefore, the policy of the Edmond Public Schools Board of Education not to approve out-of-district transfer requests, except as noted below.

1. **Dependent School Districts:** The Board authorizes the Superintendent to give consideration for possible transfer, to PK through entering 8th grade students who live within the Oakdale Dependent School District geographic boundaries as verified by Oklahoma County Tax Assessor records. Oakdale resident students are entitled by law to attend Edmond Public Schools upon entry into their freshman year of high school.
2. **Out of District Teacher/Student Transfer:** Upon approval by the superintendent and pursuant to regulations, a student whose residence is not within the boundary of Edmond Schools shall be allowed to transfer into the Edmond School district if the parent, custodial parent or legal guardian of the student is employed as a teacher by the district. A teacher is defined by statute as any person who is employed to serve as principal, supervisor, counselor, librarian, school nurse or classroom teacher, or in any other instructional supervisory, or administrative capacity, (70-1-116). This transfer need be approved by the receiving district only. (70-8-113).

Inter-district transfer requests submitted for Edmond Public Schools' consideration are subject to procedural requirements of Oklahoma statutes governing inter-district transfers.
